LONDON'S TRANSPORT MUSEUM

A The buses

The first buses appeared on the streets of London in 1829. They didn't have engines - horses used to pull them - and they were only for rich people. They had a driver, of course, and a conductor. These men looked after the horses as well as the passengers.
